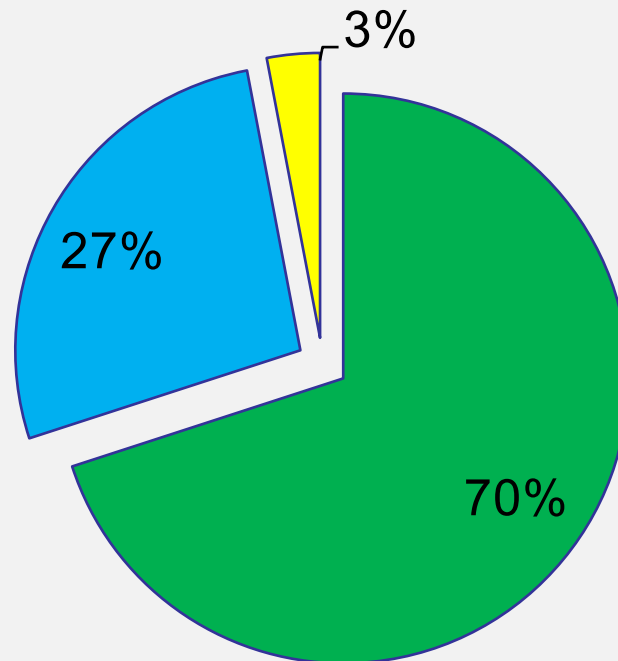

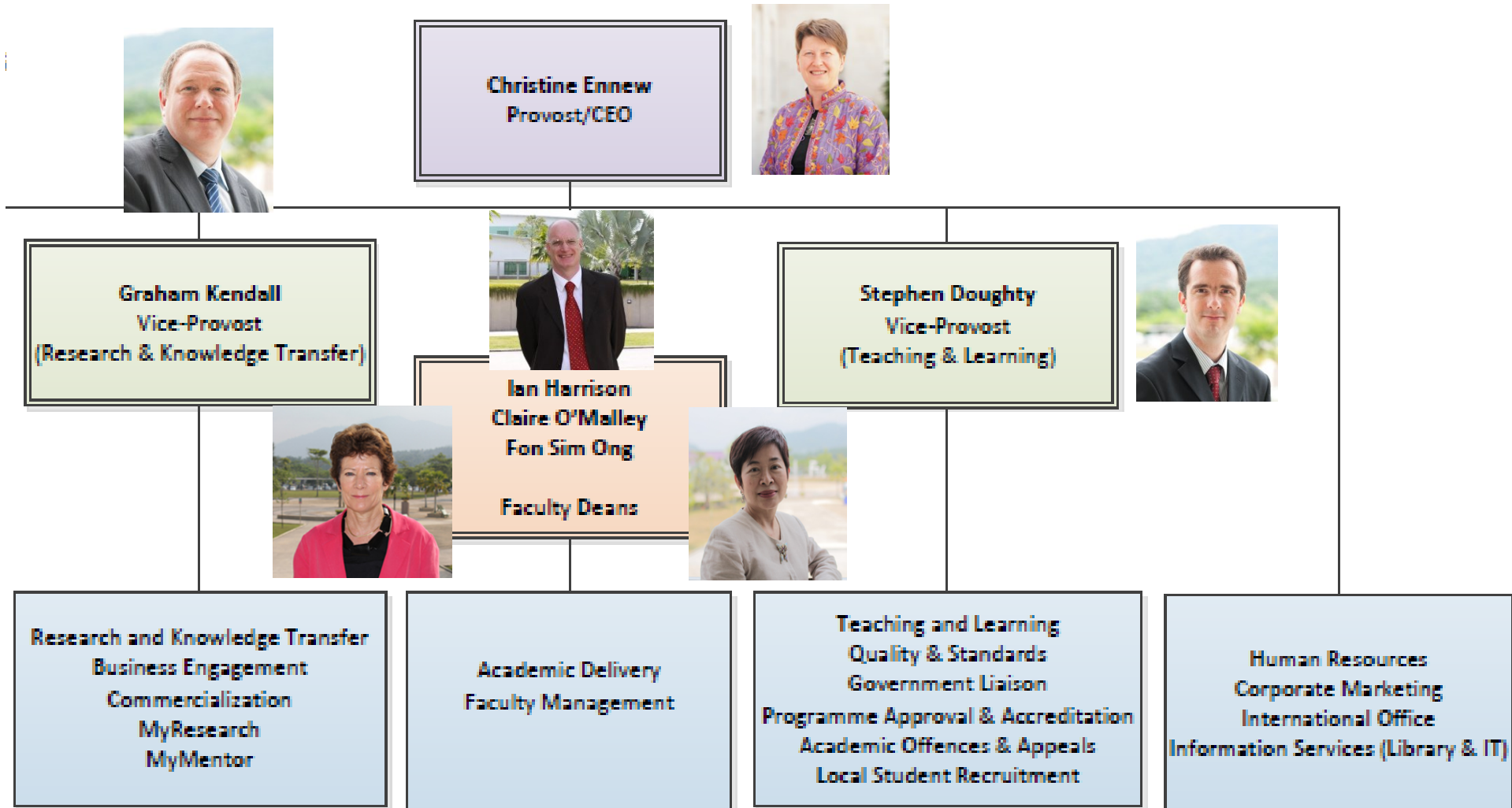
Malaysia Campus

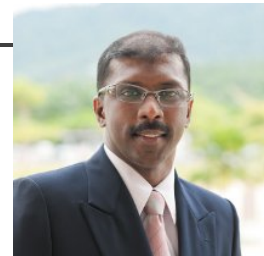

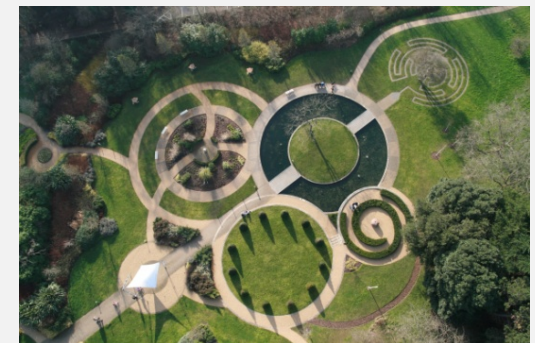

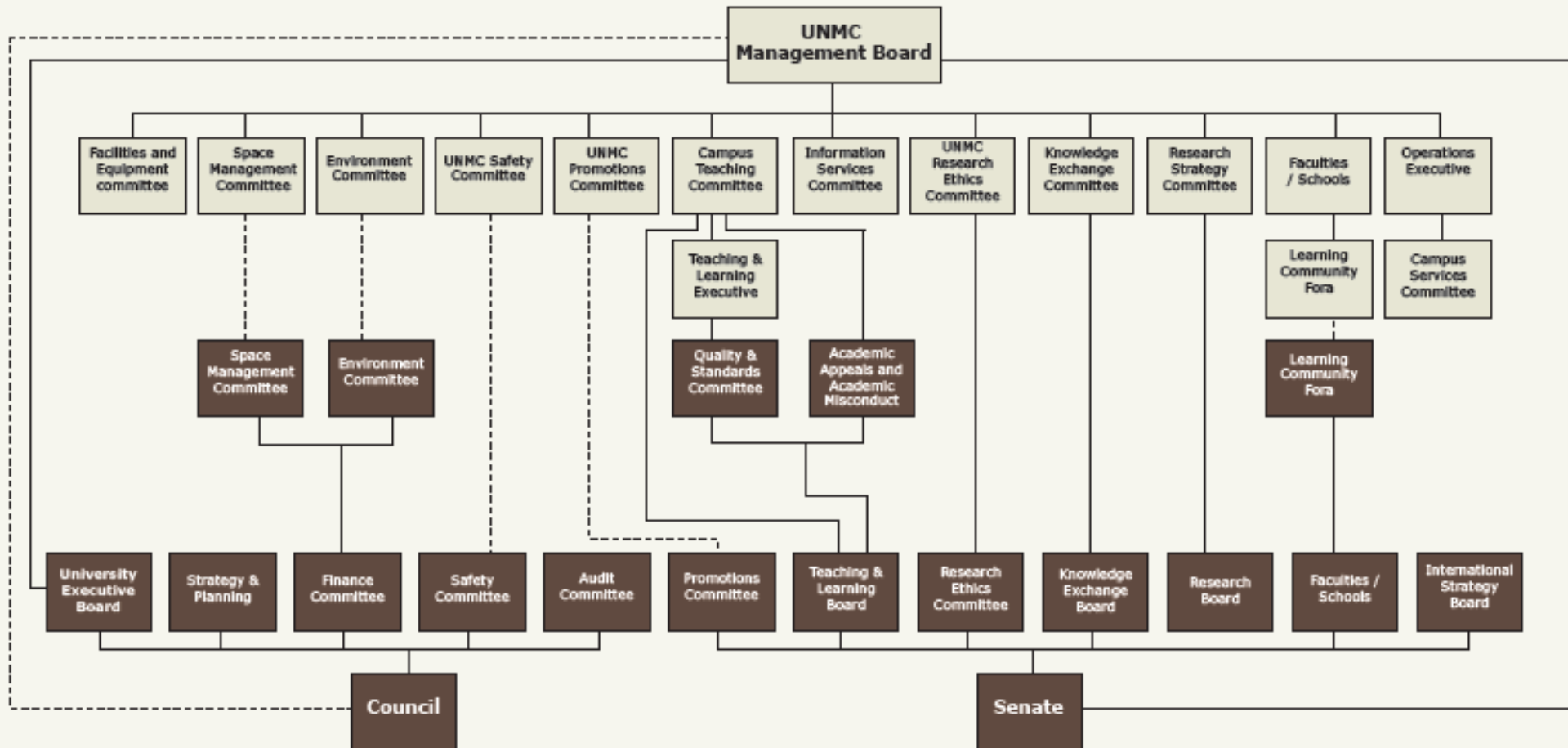

Quality Manual

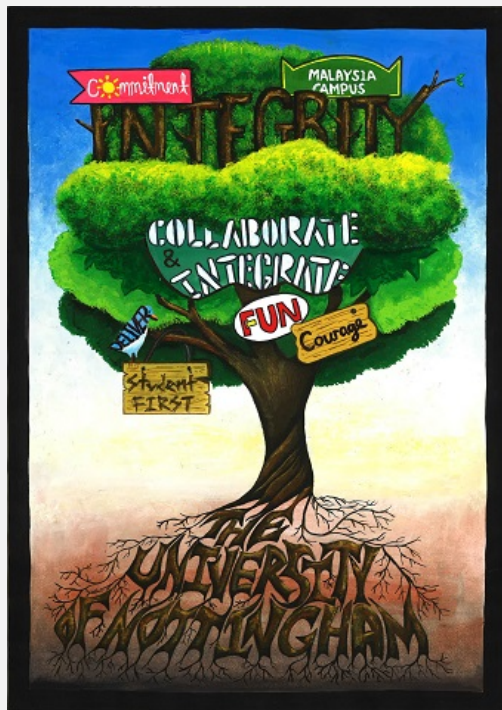
- Only programmes fully approved in Nottingham are delivered in Malaysia
